



Flying Field Rules



- 1. Flying over the pit area, structures, parking area, or spectators, is prohibited.**
- 2. Refer to enclosed diagrams for flight patterns. Stay out of the areas labeled "No Fly Zone."**
- 3. Take-off and landing will always be parallel to the flight line, regardless of wind conditions. Taxiing into the pits is not allowed.**
- 4. All flyers will use the designated flight stations.**
- 5. Pit area will be on the South side at North Collins, South side at the Nike Base, and East side at Emerling, at all times.**
- 6. No aircraft will be flown or tested, if there is a known or obvious defect with the model or equipment.**
- 7. Safety or preflight checks will be done before each first flight of a flying session.**
- 8. Novice pilots shall fly only with an instructor, until takeoffs and landing can be done safely. The Club has a list of qualified instructors.**
- 9. Flight ceiling is 1200 ft. between sunrise and sunset, but you must immediately yield to full scale aircraft.**
- 10. Only 4 airplanes are permitted in the air at any time at North Collins, 4 at Emerling, and 5 at the Nike Base.**
- 11. Immediately, after landing, pilot will remove their plane from the field. Linger on the field will not be tolerated for your own safety.**
- 12. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed while operating model aircraft.**
- 13. Members are responsible for the safety at the field and should take corrective action against unsafe conduct.**
- 14. Night flying is allowed only for electrics, and only with proper lighting on the aircraft.**
- 15. If flying on 72 MHz, you are responsible for coordinating with other flyers on 72 MHz to avoid interference.**

- 16. All members must have a current AMA license or Flying Knights membership card with them while flying and show it on request. They must abide by the field rules, the AMA safety code and FAA regulations at the field or event.***
- 17. Non-members are welcome, if they are with a Club member, and are AMA members. They must abide by the rules and have a current AMA membership.***
- 18. It is recommended that all Radio Controlled Model Aircraft have owner's ID label in or on the model to be covered by AMA Insurance.***
- 19. Engines must meet noise requirements of 98 decibels at 9 ft. taken at 4 points with average reading.***
- 20. No internal combustion engines to be run before 10:00 a.m.***
- 21. Unleashed animals are not permitted at the fields.***
- 22. Each member is responsible for their own litter.***
- 23. Failure to comply with these rules may result in being expelled from the Club and/or banned from using the field.***
